DIVYANGJAN POLICY

POLICY FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES:

The Constitution of India ensures equality, freedom, justice and dignity of all individuals and mandates an inclusive society for all including persons with disabilities (PWD) The Government of India signed UNCRPD and enacted Rights of Persons with Disability Act 2016 that recognizes that persons with disability are entitled to equal opportunities & rights to participate in the political, social, and economic and self- development activities in all walks of life. In keeping with the developments at the National and International level, the Government of Maharashtra has taken several initiatives to align with the national agenda. These guidelines apply to all the College students, faculty, and staff.

OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY:

- To create a suitable regulatory mechanism for effective delivery of services to Disable Students and Staff of the College.
- To provide accessible and inclusive education on the College campus.
- To ensure full participation of persons with disabilities and to provide them the equal development opportunities.
- As per government norms and UGC recommendation a person with disability (Divyanjan) is given special attention in college.
- As per norms , three percent reservation are kept vacant till last date of admission.
- Special provisions are made such as
 - a) Separate class room on ground floor to avoid discomfort.
 - b) Ramp is constructed which provides easy access to students/staff (PWD) to the classroom.
 - c) Provision of wheelchair and support stick is made for person with disability.
